MOTION TO PROHIBIT MENTIONING DEFENDANT'S RELIGION

The Defendant, **DONALD WAYNE HARTUNG**, files this his MOTION TO PROHIBIT THE STATE FROM BRINGING INTO EVIDENCE OR DISCUSSING DEFENDANT'S RELIGIOUS AFFILIATION and says:

- 1. Defendant was indicted by a Grand Jury and is charged with three (3) counts of first-degree murder;
- 2. The State is seeking the Death Penalty in the instant case;
- 3. During the investigative phase of this case, it was mentioned by law enforcement that Defendant Donald Wayne Hartung was a Wiccan and that the practice of his religion somehow contributed to the murder of his Mother and two (2) Step-brothers.
- 4. That there is no evidence that Defendant's religion, in any way, would predispose Defendant to commit a murder or would have any relevance or bearing upon the instant case.
- 5. During depositions, one of the investigators in the instant case stated that he did not believe that religion had any relationship to the instant crime.

- 6. To mention Defendant's religion and religious beliefs would be highly prejudicial and would deny Defendant a fair trial and violate his constitutional rights under the United States Constitution, specifically, the First (1<sup>st</sup>), Fourth (4<sup>th</sup>), Fifth (5<sup>th</sup>), Sixth (6<sup>th</sup>), Eighth (8<sup>th</sup>), and Fourteenth (14<sup>th</sup>) Amendments as well as the applicable Amendments to the Florida Constitution;
- 7. Any mention of Defendant's religion would have such a prejudicial effect as to outweigh any probative value;

WHEREFORE, Defendant, DONALD WAYNE HARTUNG, respectfully requests that this Honorable Court prohibit the Government from mentioning his religious beliefs during the trial of this case.
